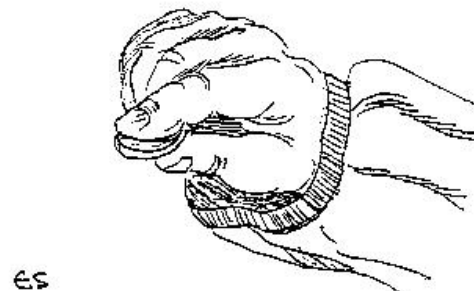
Compared to the old days, children nowadays grow up in an environment which is less conducive to developing these skills. In the womb, fetuses are faced with the diagnostic languages of the doctors more than the comforting languages of the mothers. This might cause stress to the babies and create blocks to language development. As babies, they are given pacifiers when they wanted to cry. As students, they are required to sit in front of a desk for long hours. School life is becoming more and more stressful. Children, teenagers are expressing themselves more with computers and SMS. Children are encouraged to use their hands and fingers less.



Renate Wennekes will talk about the effects of these modern-day phenomena on the development of the child. She will show us how to take pre-cautions for our children and for ourselves as adults. She will give us some practical advices and movements we can do to help integrate the development of such skills.
